



Easier to talk about than to bring about




New Orleans Saints

Task Needs




Particular objectives the team is working toward:

Maintenance Needs






The next half

What is the primary goal of the team?



Releasing the reins of leadership




"Show me a manager who's afraid a subordinate is going to get their job, and I'll show you a manager whose subordinate is going to get their job."

Conflict/Consensus




Effective vs. Ineffective Group



 The difference between an effective group and an ineffective group is not whether or not they had a conflict, but how it is managed and resolved.

So how do you resolve conflict?



Vote! – That's the worst thing you can do



You immediately divide the group of 5:

- 3 yes
- 2 no

Those 2 people walk out and say:

"If that's the way you want to do it, well go ahead, but don't look to me for any help. I'll show you that was not the right way to go."
