

USACE DREDGING ACCIDENT STATISTICS








SWG ACCIDENT EXPOSURE ANALYSIS


- Total Dredging Exposure Hours for FY16: 629,903 (47.7% increase from FY15)

- o 1 accident every 125,980 hours worked











 - o Drug screen records








COMMON ISSUES WITH ACCIDENT PREVENTION PLANS CONTINUED
